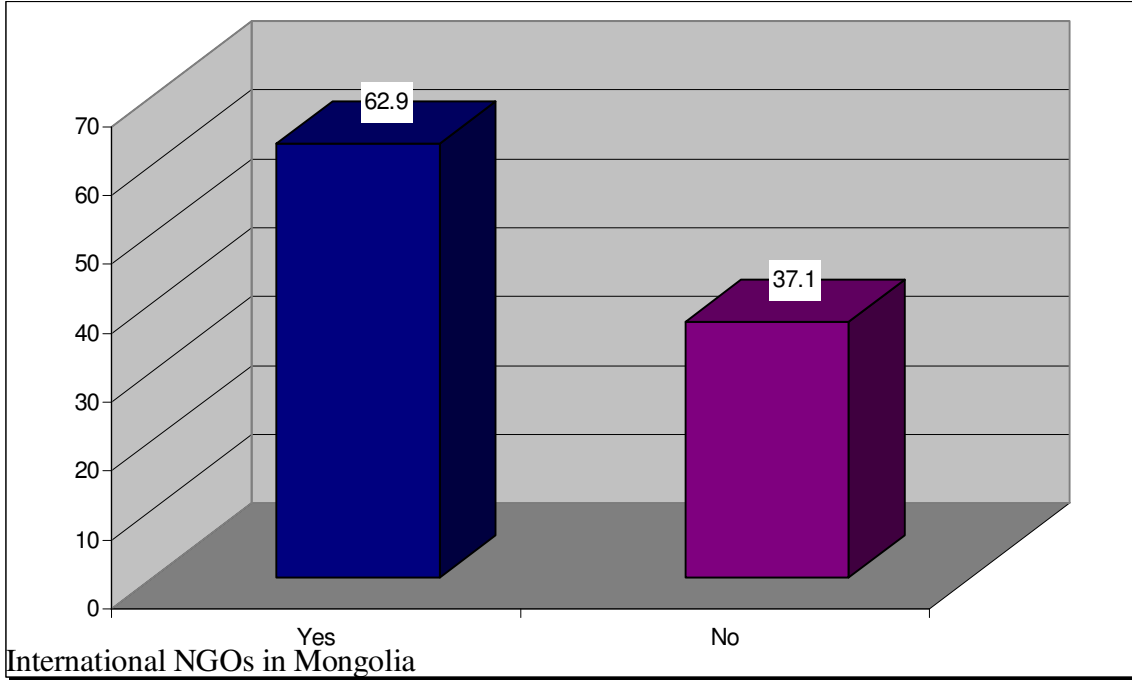
N = 305 respondents

Objective of the survey is studying public attitude on International NGOs in Mongolia and extent of their activities.

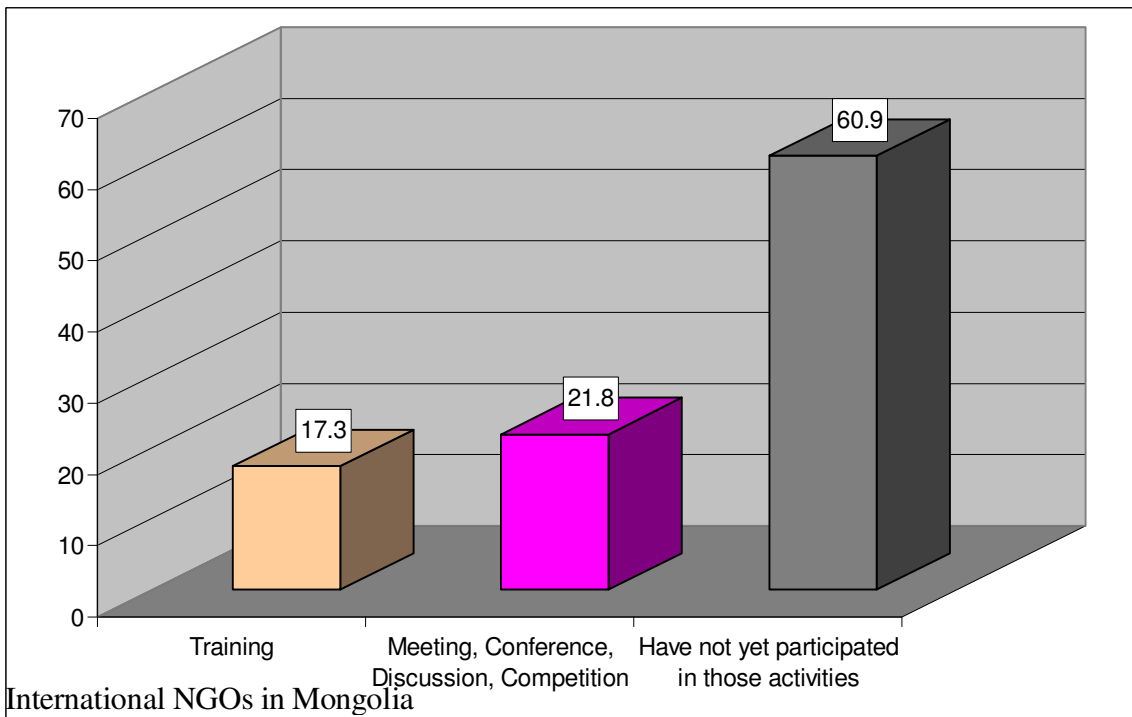
The survey was conducted in six aimags (Selenge, Darkhan-Uul, Zavkhan, Khovd, Umnugobi, Dornod) and Ulaanbaatar. Aimags are represented four geographical and economic zones of Mongolia. 210 respondents from the aimags and 95 respondents from UB were randomly selected and surveyed.

Data collection was completed by Department of Social Science, MSUE.

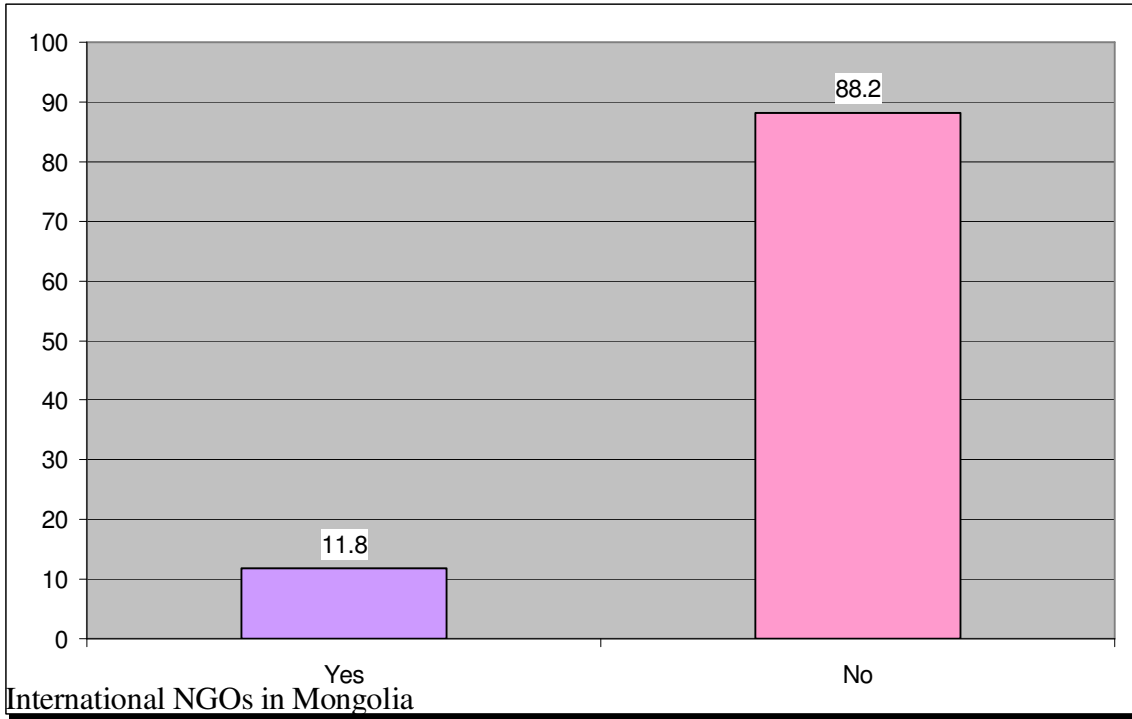
1. Have you ever received information about International NGOs in Mongolia from mass media?



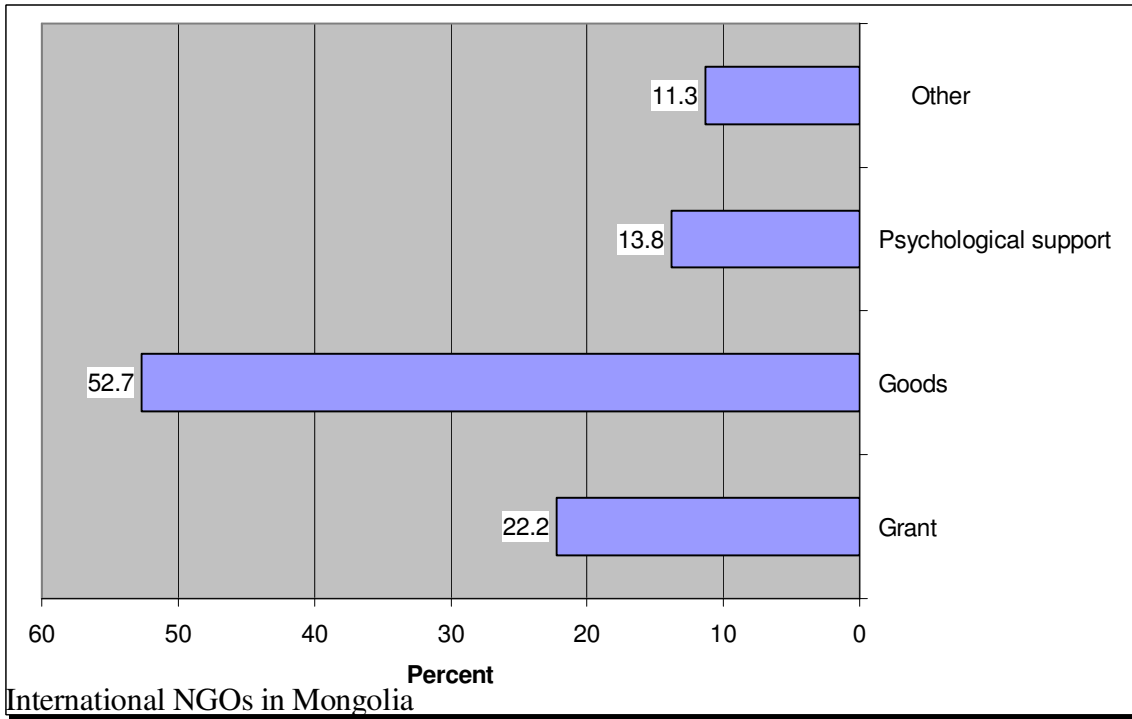
2. Have you ever participated in the following activities, which were organized by International NGOs in Mongolia?



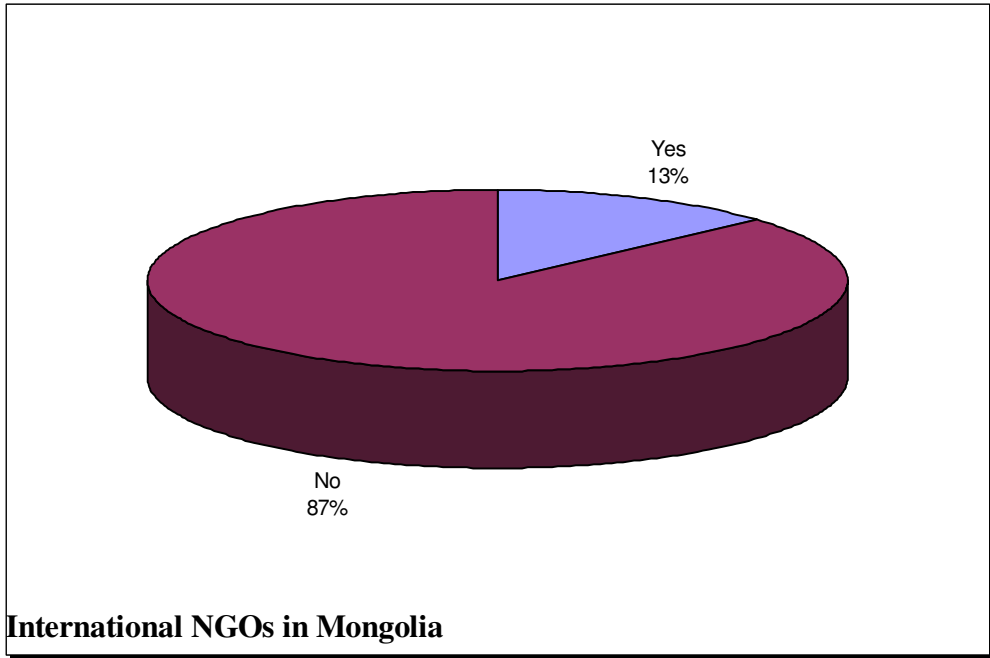
3. Have you ever received any aids or assistance from International NGOs in Mongolia?



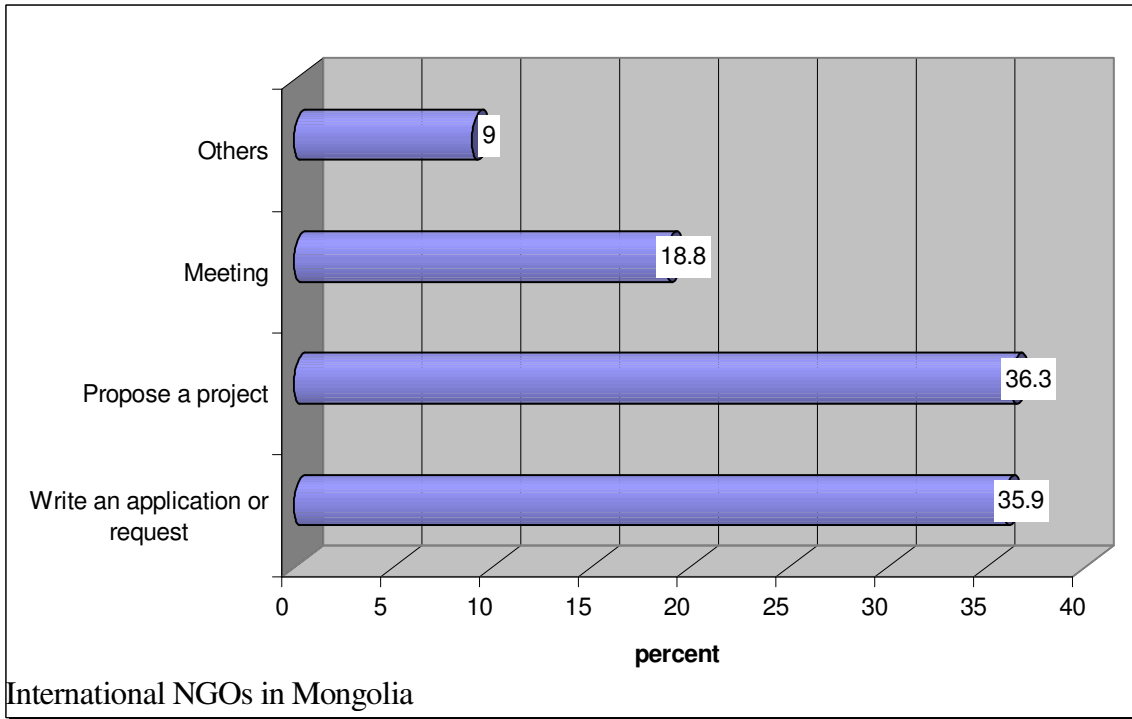
4. If yes, what kind of aid or assistance:



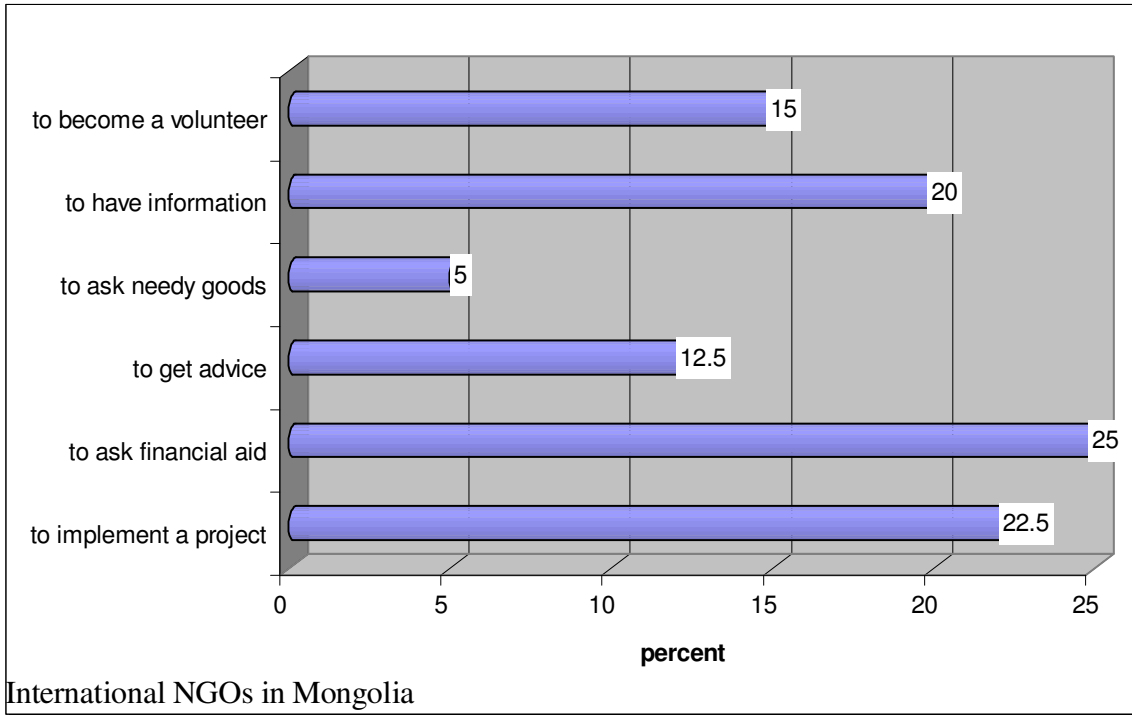
5. Have you ever applied to any International NGO in Mongolia?



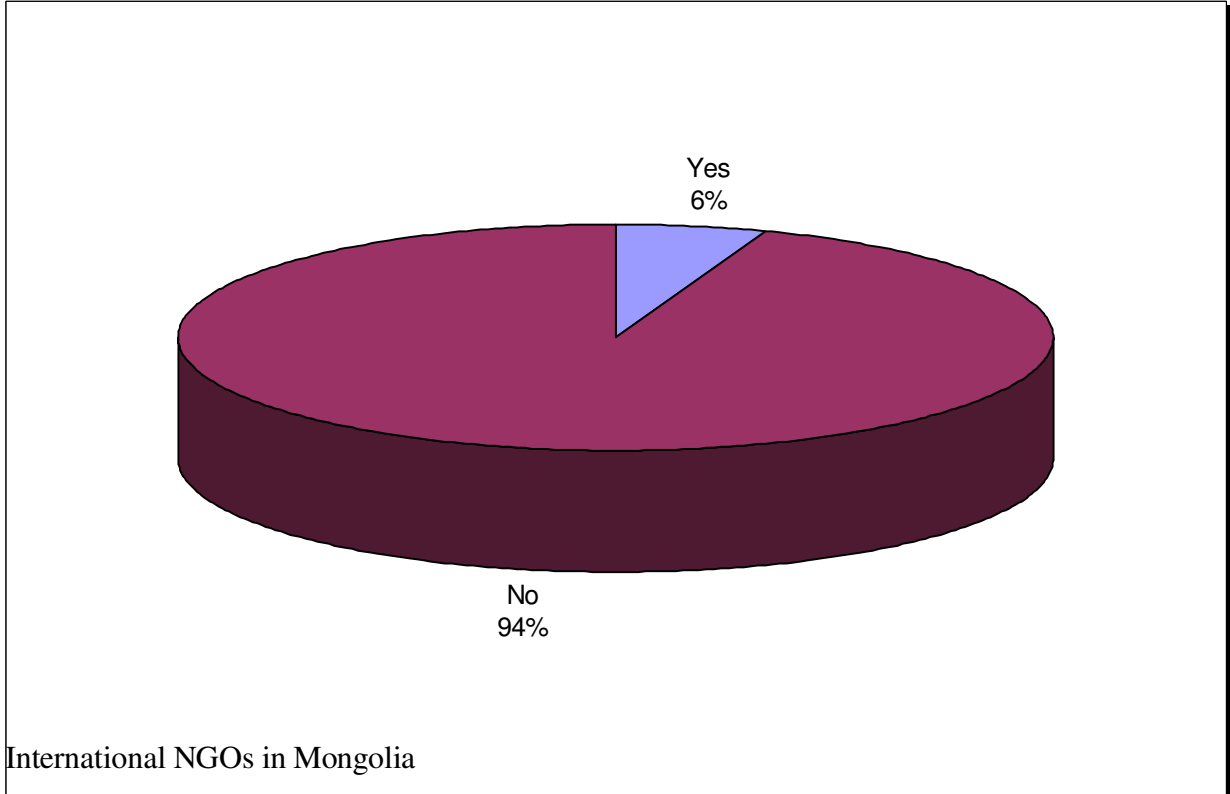
6. If yes, how did you apply?



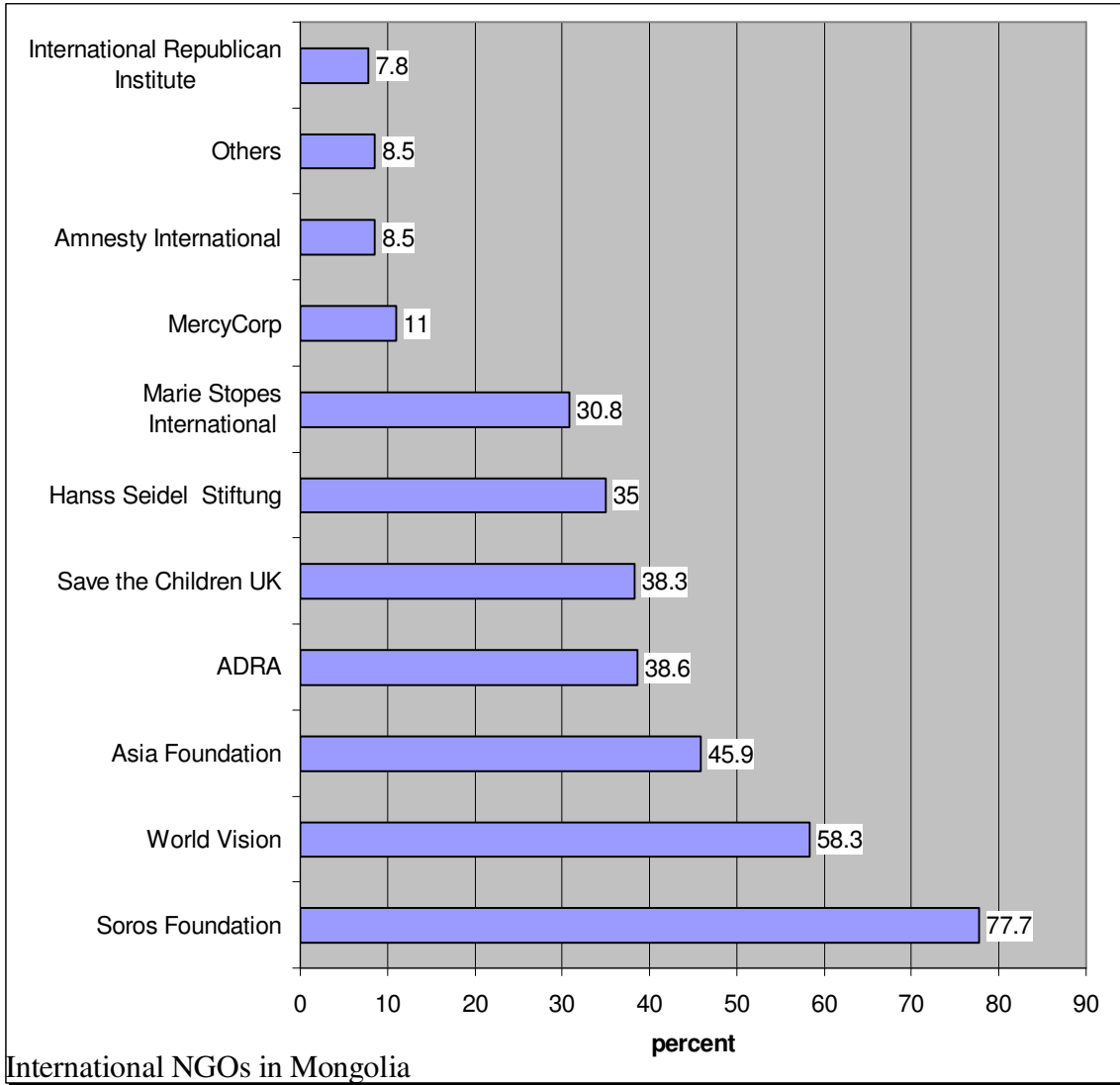
7. For what purpose did you apply?



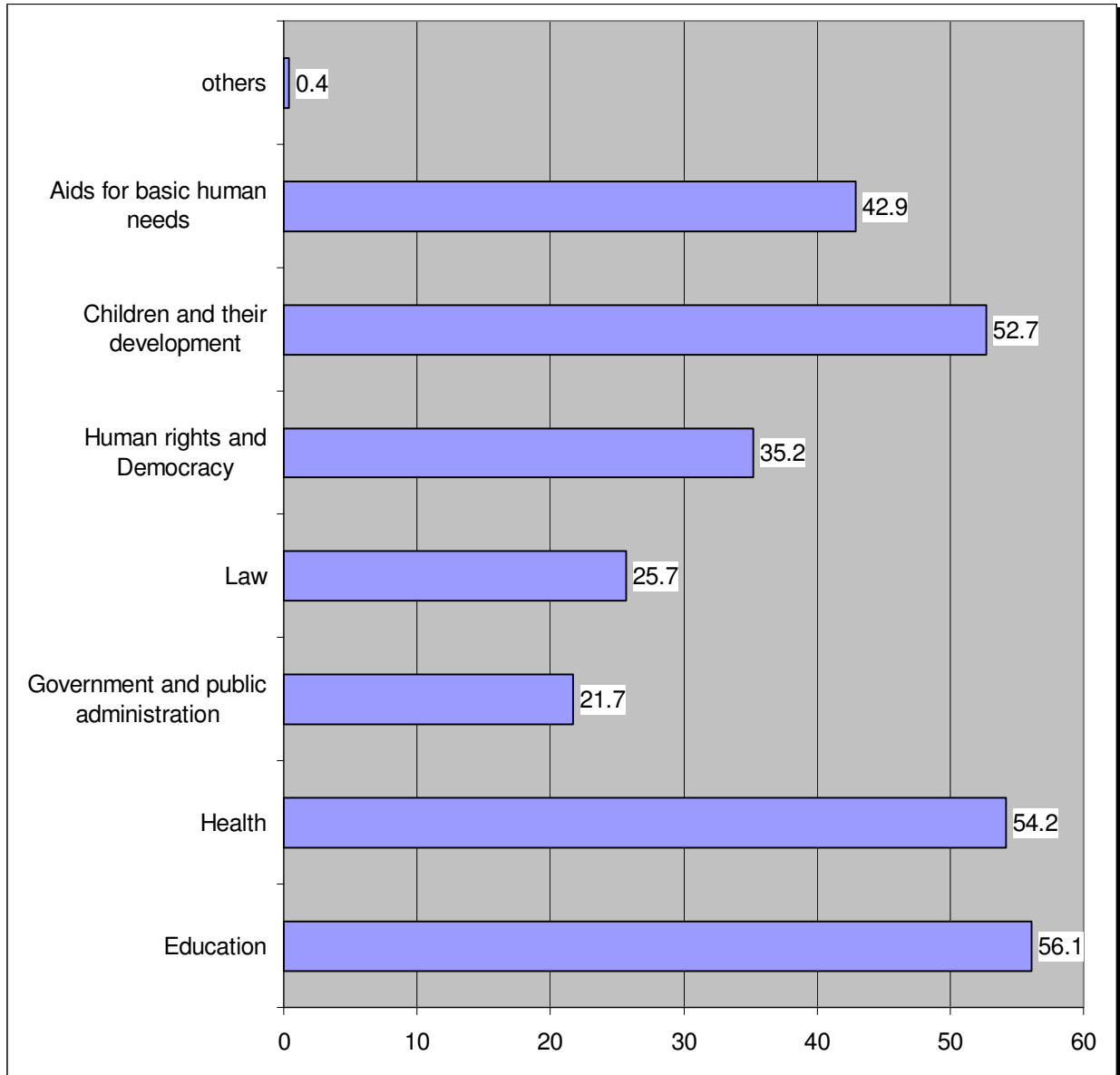
8. Are you member of any international NGOs in Mongolia?



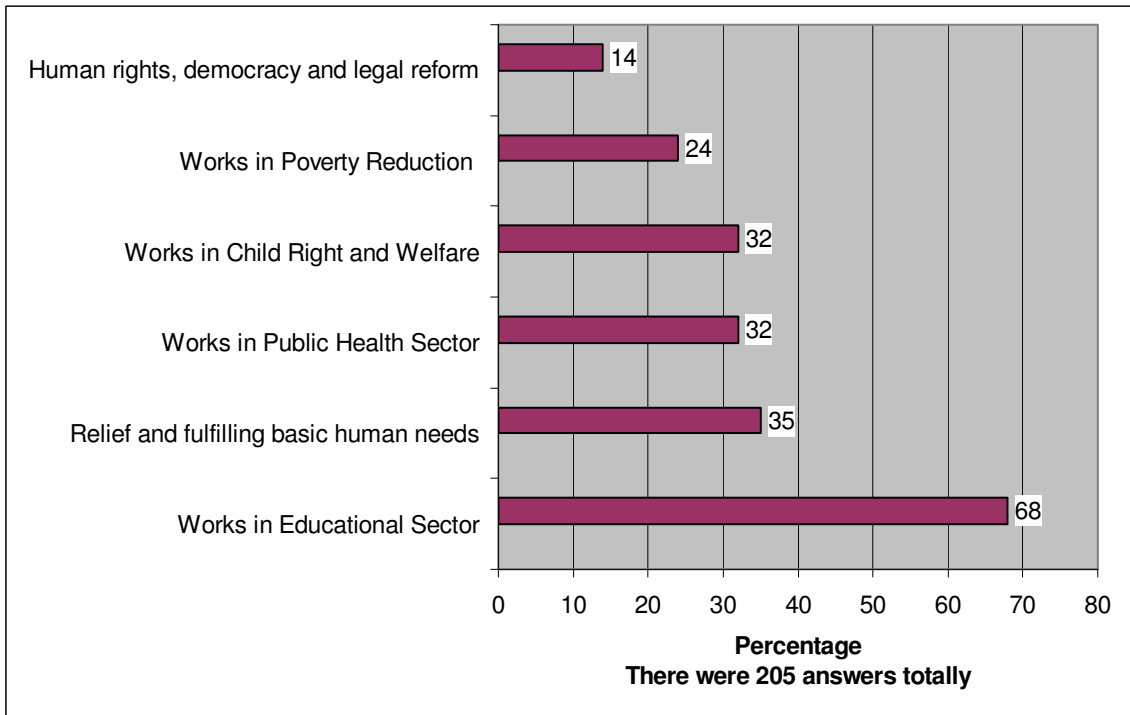

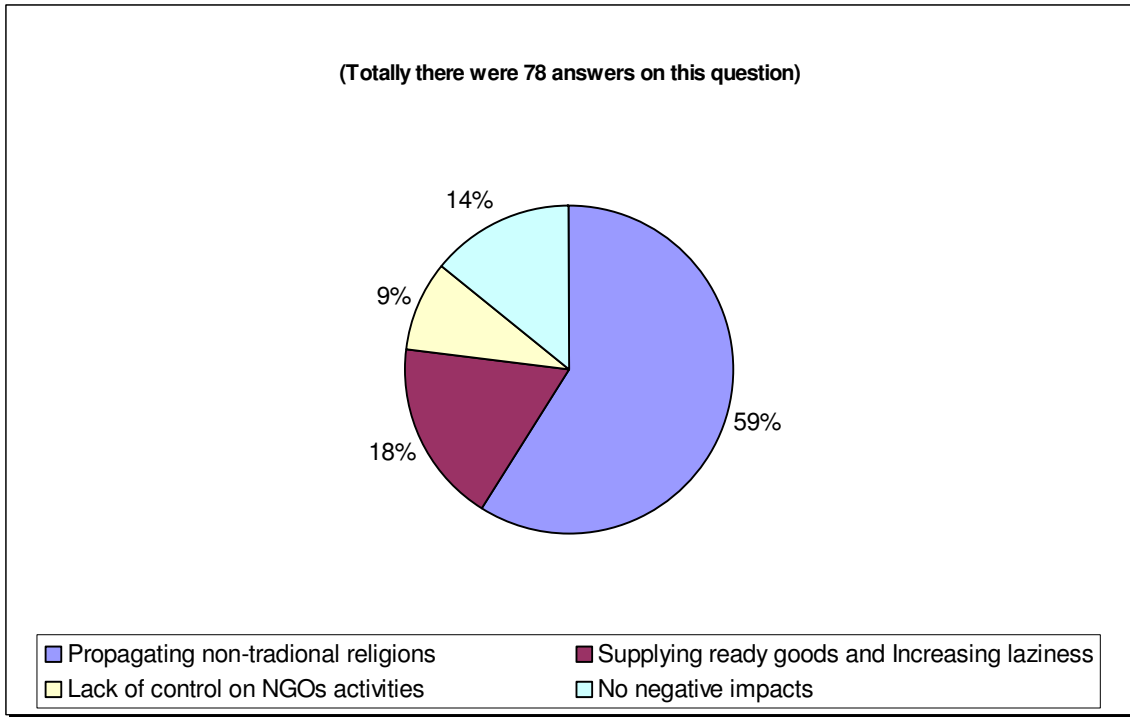
**10. What are, in your opinion, the fields where International NGOs are working efficiently?

12. What is, in your opinion, the negative impact of International NGOs on Mongolian society? (It was also open question and respondents had to write their thoughts freely.)

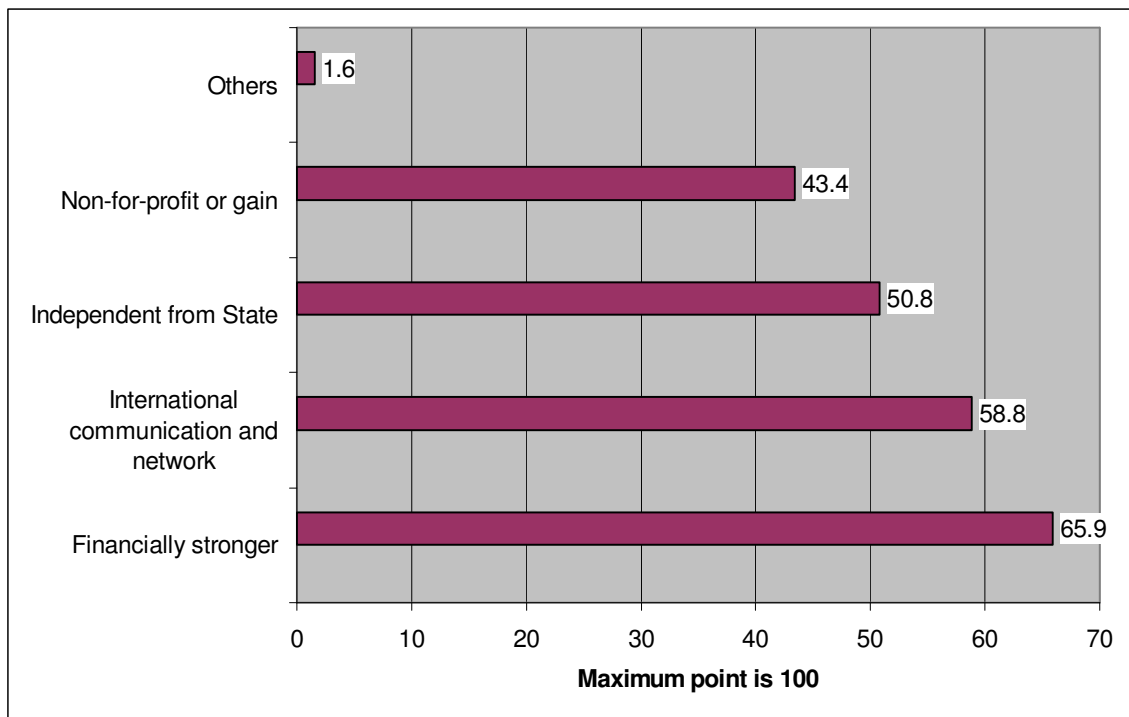


13. What are, in your opinion, the drawbacks or negative sides in activities of International NGOs in Mongolia? (It was open question and respondents had to write their thoughts freely.)

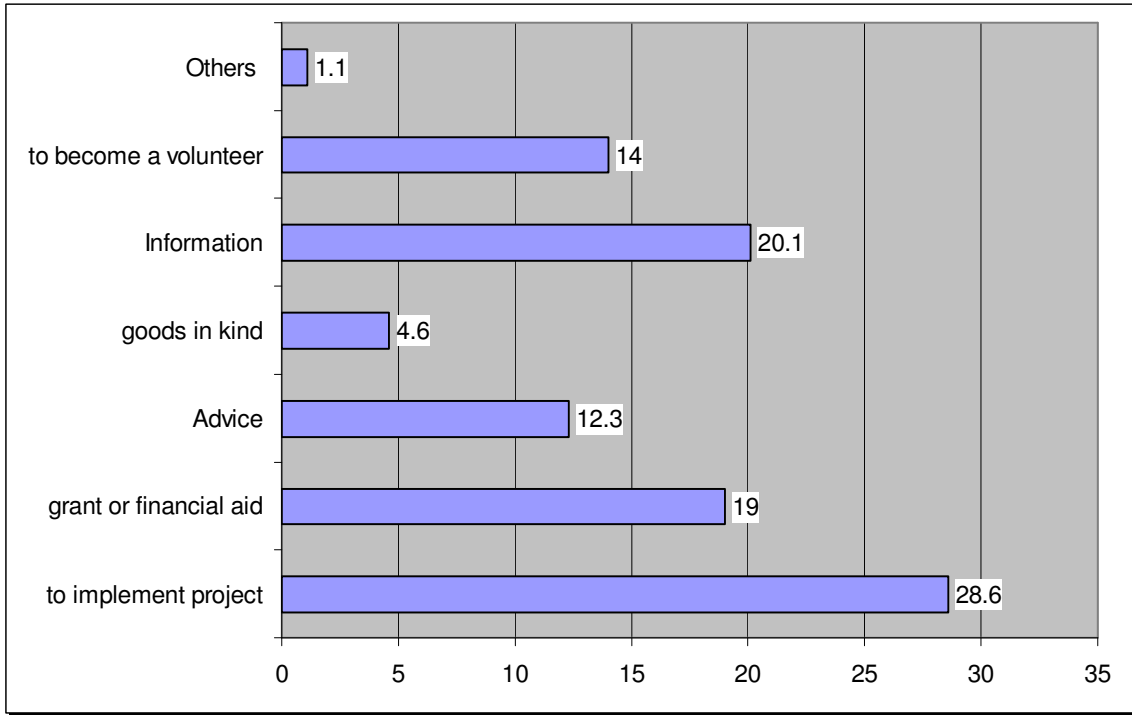
The answers were very fragmented and diverse. We are presenting only answers, which were given by more than 10 respondents. These are;

- International NGOs are not working open for public.
- There is lack of information about International NGOs in Mongolia
- International NGOs did not report their activities to public
- Activities of International NGOs usually focus on vulnerable part of society and do not reach whole population.
- There are very few long-term effects of their activities on Mongolian society
- International NGOs have very little expertise about local conditions
- International NGOs often work with only few officials

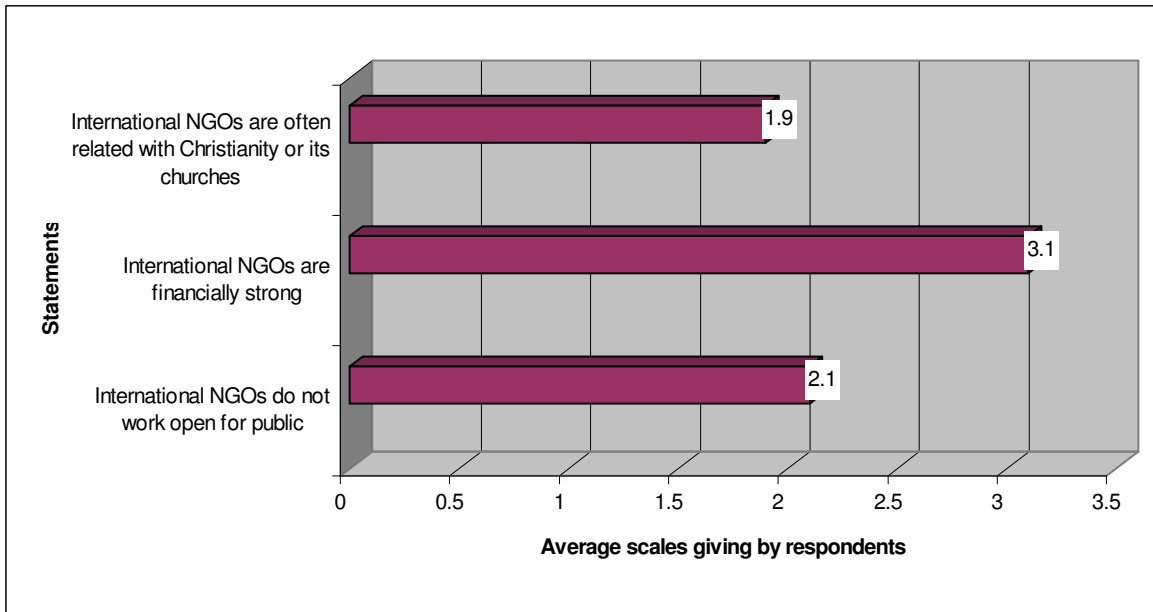
